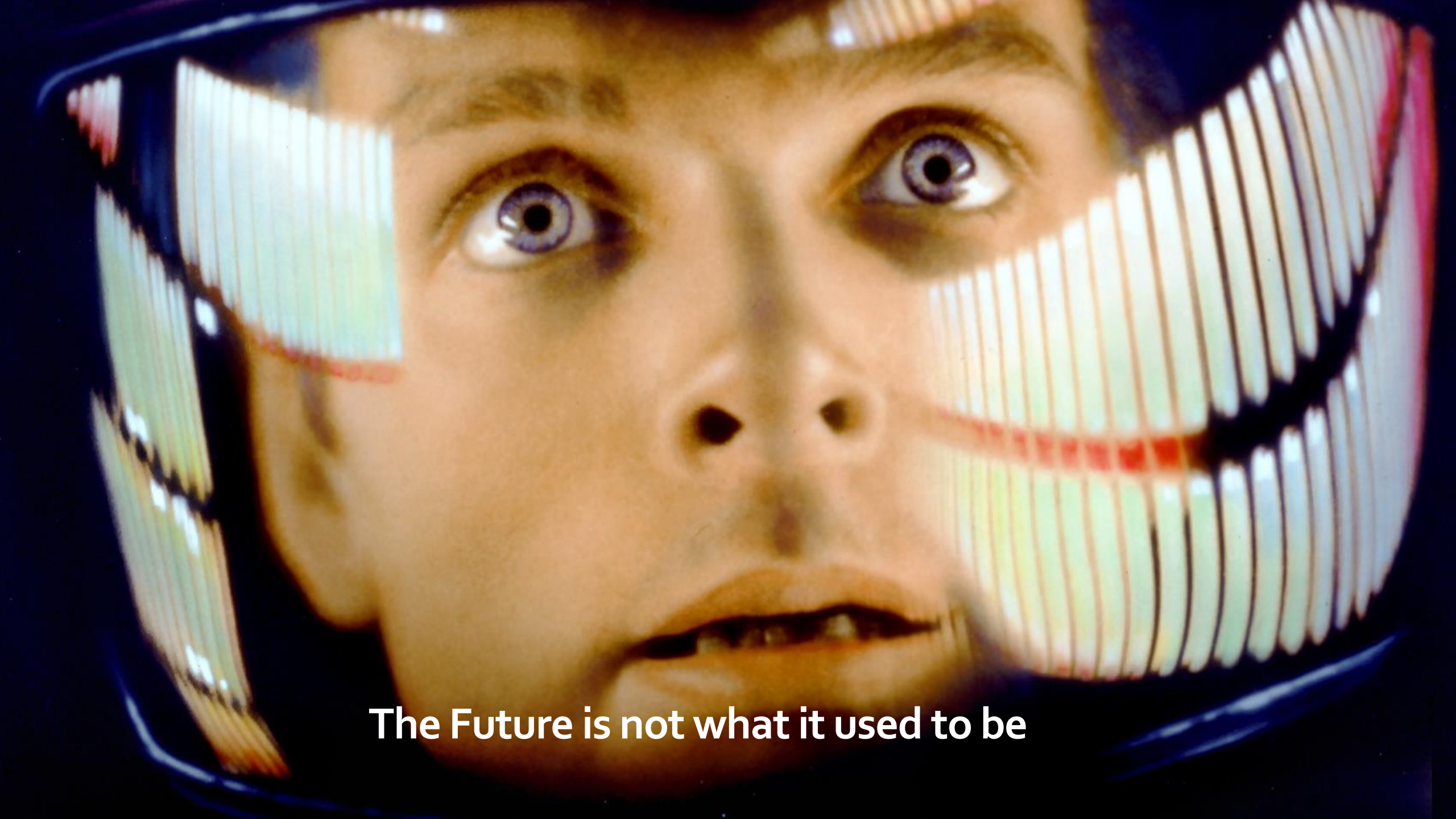

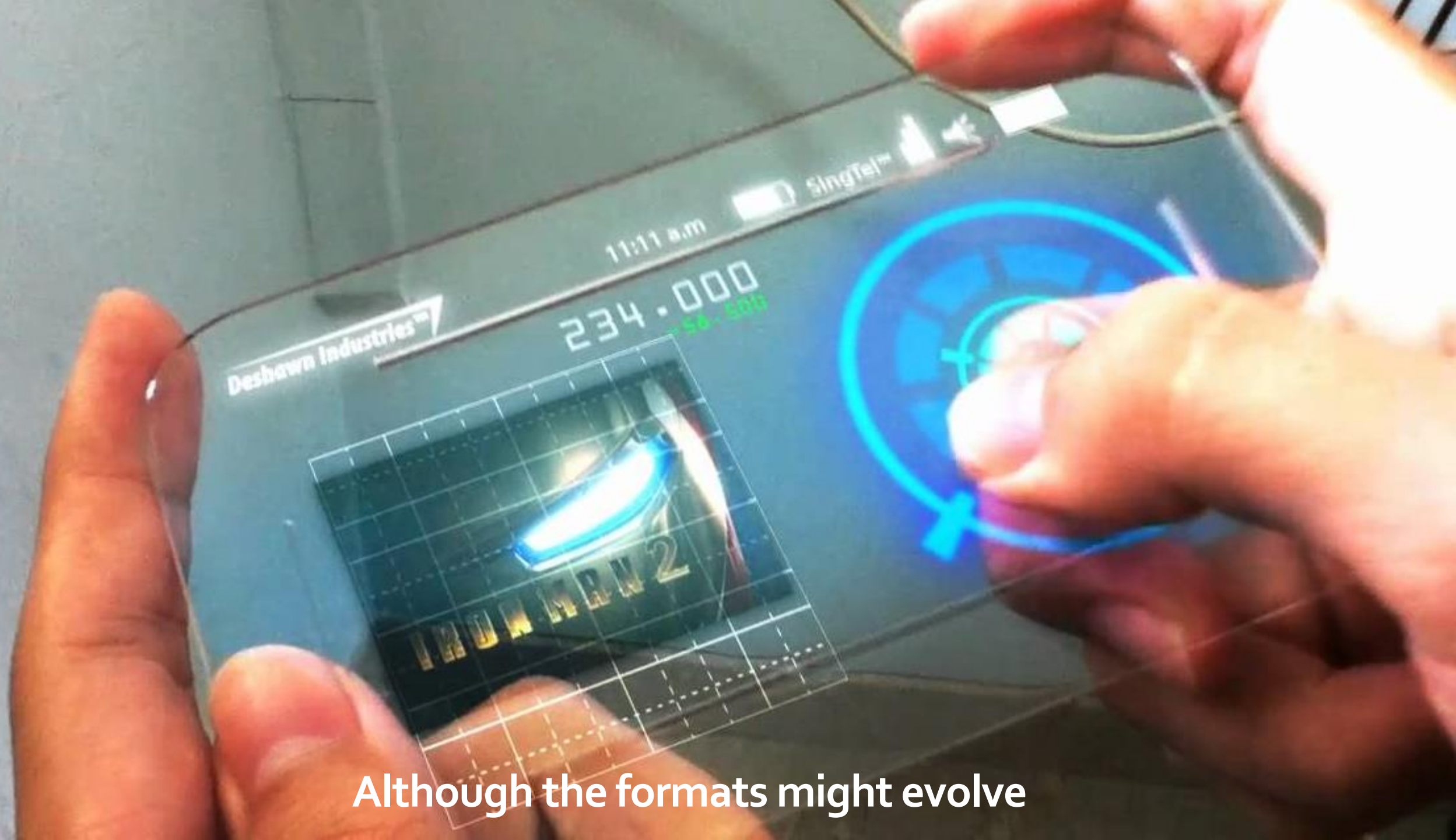

Alternate low assurance eIDs will be available for non-verified residents



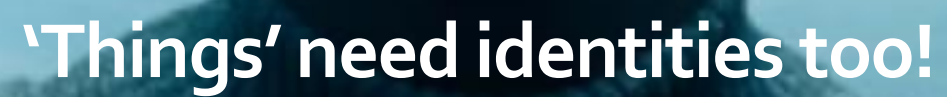
Stepping-up Levels of Assurance will be natural
